WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 103C.331, subdivision 11, Comprehensive Plan, authorizes Minnesota Soil and Water Conservation Districts to develop and implement a comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the counties and soil and water conservation districts within the Pine River Watershed (Major Watershed District Number 11), as delineated in the attached One Watershed, One Plan Suggested Boundary Map, have interest in developing a comprehensive watershed management plan for this area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Crow Wing SWCD recognizes and supports watershed-scale planning efforts consistent with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 103B.801, also known as One Watershed, One Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Crow Wing SWCD welcomes the opportunity to collaborate with the counties and soil and water conservation districts within the Pine River Watershed for watershed-scale planning efforts in the future; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Crow Wing SWCD supports an application to the Board of Water and Soil Resources for a planning grant to develop a comprehensive watershed management plan and anticipates entering into a Memorandum of Agreement with the counties and soil and water conservation districts, within the Pine River Watershed, to collaborate on this effort, pending selection as a recipient of a planning grant.
